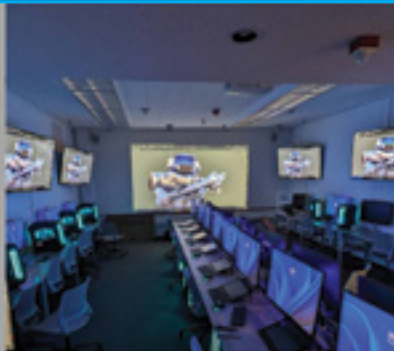

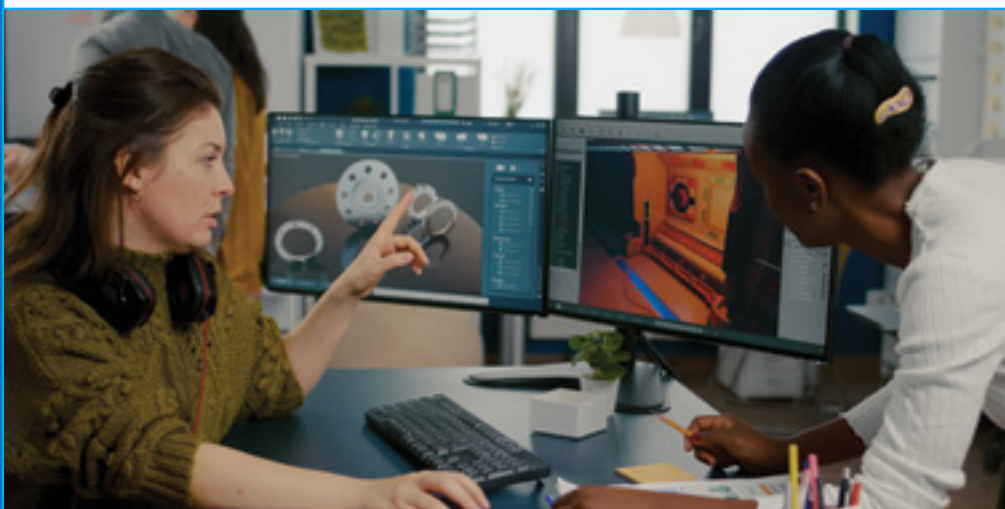

Class meets online on a weekday evening. Each student will also participate in a weekly 30 minute, one-on-one session with a mentor. Students start each academic week on Sunday and are required to watch all videos and start working on assignments/projects before their online class meeting. Course consists of 13-18 hours of weekly homework and content, including career service assignments utilizing LinkedIn.

**Prerequisites:** Students must be 18 or over and have a high school diploma or equivalent. Basic computer literacy and the ability to navigate one's own computer is strongly preferred. Students will complete an aptitude test prior to the first class session.

**Technical Requirements:** Students must have access to a computer with a minimum of 8GB RAM and i5 processor. Class utilizes both Zoom and Slack for meetings and communication. Although not required, students may find a second monitor extremely helpful.

### BACK END SOFTWARE

#### DEVELOPER BOOT CAMP ONLINE

#210190: Back End Software Developers are in charge of building applications that do the behind-the-scenes work. This typically involves receiving requests from a Front End application, processing the request, reading and writing to a database, and responding back to requests from other applications.

In this 18-week, Back End Software Development program, students take three courses to learn the skills and technologies necessary to enter the industry as a Back End Software Developer: Introduction to Java, Relational Databases with MySQL, and Web API Design with Spring Boot. Skills and technologies learned include Java 1.8, Algorithms, OOP, Design Patterns, Unit Testing, SQL, DDL, DML, Database Concepts, JDBC, Spring Boot, Spring Data, REST, JPA, JWT, AWS, and more.

Skills and technologies learned include JavaScript, Algorithms, OOP, Design Patterns, Unit Testing, HTML, CSS, JQuery, Bootstrap, AJAX, React, JSX, REST, NPM, AWS, and more.

**Office Hours:** 9:00am-4:00pm Monday – Friday. Closed Thursday, June 19 (Juneteenth Day Holiday), Friday, July 4 (Independence Day Holiday).

**Not-for-credit classes:** Not for K-12 or college credit. No grades assigned. Grade levels indicate the grade level children will be entering in the fall.

**Release & Medical Consent Form Required:** A completed and signed release and medical consent form is required upon registering your child for Kid's College. The Kid's College Welcome Packet will be sent to you after you have completed enrollment/payment for Kid's College classes.

The Kid's College packet will include the release and medical consent form, an emergency contact form, a pick-up/drop-off authorization form, a campus map indicating the location of the Kid's College drop-off/pick-up location, a code of conduct form and general Kid's College information.

**Lunch Supervision** provided for grades K-8 enrolled full day. Students are required to provide their own snacks and lunches.

**Easy drop-off and pick-up:** Drop off and pick up your kid at the Drop off/pick up location and your child will be escorted to/from his/her classroom. The Drop off/Pick up location opens 15 minutes before each class starts and closes 15 minutes after each class ends. DO NOT drop off your child earlier than 15 minutes prior to class start time. DO NOT pick up your child later than 15 minutes after class end time.

Kids in grades K-8, must be signed in and out each day when you drop them off and pick them up at the Kid's College Drop off/Pick up location. Kid's College staff and instructors will be at the location to welcome and walk your child to and from class each day. Important: After 4:15pm, Parents of kids grades K-8 will incur a daily \$10 late pick up fee and are to pick up their child at the Community & Continuing Education office (SOCS 101).

Kids in grades 9-12, on the first day of the start of each new class are to be dropped off and picked up at the Kid's College Drop-off/Pick-up location where they will be escorted by their instructor to their classroom.
